A problem for many Swiss citizen abroad arose when banks closed their accounts or imposed very high fees. The Organisation of the Swiss Abroad (OSA) has been fighting for many years to find a solution. The issue is coming a bit closer to a result. On 28th February 2018 the motion from Philippo Lombardi (CVP) to guarantee banking access to Swiss citizens living abroad was rejected. However, the Parliament's refusal to guarantee banking access to Swiss expatriates has now placed the onus on banks to solve the longstanding problem. There is also another motion outstanding regarding credit cards and accounts for Swiss citizen abroad. With Postfinance. OSA is working tirelessly on behalf of the Swiss citizens abroad and much has been achieved.

So our Birthday is the 14th April 1968! The foundation was layed by Saemi Reusser, Edwin Furrer, Uli Gubler and Urban Gmuer. And Saemi Reusser was also the first President. Since then a lot of water flew down the Parramatta River. Singing, Cammeradery, and Fun have been the strong pillars of the Swiss Yodlers in Sydney. Legendary trips within OZ and Overseas to the Eidg. Jodlerfest in Switzerland with an active participation and sometimes outstanding rankings have a long tradition.
