



Crèmeschnitte Chörli Covid Guidelines

on resuming rehearsals from 13 October 2020

The Choir acknowledges the Harmonie German Club Covid-19 Safety Plan and undertakes to abide fully by the principles and requirements detailed in that Plan.

The main points in the Harmonie Club's plan for patrons are:

Maintaining Good Hygiene

- Hand sanitising stations will be easily available - PLEASE USE THEM.
- Frequently touched areas will be regularly cleaned with sanitising agents throughout the day.

Physical Distancing

- Room occupancies will be maintained with the 1 person per 4 m² rule.
- Patrons are requested to be seated whenever practical.

Follow Medical Health Advice

- You will not be given access to the Club if:
 - you are showing signs or symptoms of the flu
 - you are from or have visited anyone from a known and registered hotspot
 - you have been in contact with anyone showing symptoms of Covid-19.
- All Club patrons and staff are asked to respect the medical health advice.

General

- Patrons are asked to register with their first name and contact number on entering Club premises.
- Alcoholic beverages can only be consumed while you are seated.
- Patrons should remain seated at all times - except when entering and exiting the club, ordering food and beverages, or visiting the washrooms (please use washrooms in the proximity of your seating area).

Choral practice by nature carries a higher risk for spreading airborne diseases, therefore these additional choir-specific rules are to be followed:

- Choristers are responsible for assessing their own health. Anyone who is not feeling 100% well is asked NOT to come to rehearsals.
- Please sanitise your hands on entering the Keller and try to avoid touching surfaces.
- Chairs will be set up and sanitised before the rehearsal. Please do not move them.
- While singing, choristers will be spaced at 2 metres apart (i.e. if you stretch out your arms and can touch each other then you are too close). Please keep to social distancing rules at all other times (sorry, that means no hand-shaking or kissing...).
- Sheet music will only be handed out by the musical director. Any sheet music given to choir members will remain the property of the chorister and will not be returned to the library. Music sheets are not to be shared between choristers.
- Adequate ventilation will be provided by opening doors/windows whenever possible.
